



ELEMENTARY REGATHERING FAQS

Do I need to register my child in advance?

No! As of March 7, 2021, we no longer require families to register their kids in advance. Just show up and we'll get you all checked in!

Where will Elementary be meeting at BCA?

BCA Kids Elementary will be meeting upstairs in the Kids Center. Opening the walls of the rooms will allow us to maintain social distancing.

What age of kids will be meeting at BCA Kids Elementary?

BCA Kids Elementary is for Kindergarten through 5th Graders (5 to 11 years old).

Will I need to check-in my child?

Yes! In order to keep BCA Kids Elementary a safe environment, a parent or guardian must be present at check-in. Your child will receive a name tag and you will receive a Guardian receipt. Both have a randomized code that will be matched at check-out.

Are masks required?

We ask that everyone who attends our services, including volunteers, wear a face covering.

Will my child have fun?

Of course! We have fun games and activities planned that are safe for kids to play.

Will kids be social distancing?

In an effort to keep kids safe and healthy, we have hula hoops spaced 6 feet apart on the ground that kids will sit in during service. Their hoop is their bubble. All of our games and activities are designed for kids to be spaced apart and have minimal contact of shared items.

What happens in an Elementary service?

Every service starts out with Praise & Worship, followed by announcements, games, and a fun, interactive message with an opportunity to respond to what the Holy Spirit is saying to them.

Will Bible Bucks be given out?

During this time, we have designed “Bible Buck Credit Cards” that kids will receive at the end of service. While kids earn points for playing games, bringing their Bible, completing take home activities, and more, these points are turned into Bible Bucks. Our Score Keeper will write in the amount on the Bible Buck Credit Card to be placed in the pre-packaged Take Home bags for kids as they leave.

Will the Bible Buck Store be open?

Our Bible Buck Store will be open on the first Sunday of each month. It has been newly designed to ensure minimal to no touch points for kids.

Will offering be taken?

Yes! In our elementary service, we do not pass buckets. Instead, we have multiple buckets on stage that kids can come up and place their offering in.

What happens before and after service?

We have created new activities that kids can participate in where they social distance and use items just for them.

Will materials be handed out?

Any materials that need to be handed out will be placed in their hula hoop before service or pre-packaged for them to “grab and go” after service.

Are volunteers background checked?

Yes! Only volunteers who have been background checked and interviewed are allowed beyond check-in to serve and work with kids.
