DIAPER CHANGING AREAS

Diaper changing areas are located in each restroom, as well as in the nursery and in the nursing mother's room.

FAMILY ROOM

If your child is reluctant to stay in the nursery, please enjoy the worship service with your child in our sound-proof Family Room, located off the left side of the Worship Center, across from the south stairwell. Here you can look into the Worship Center and enjoy the service via live feed as well.

BABY & CHILD DEDICATION

A baby and child dedication ceremony is held at various times throughout the year. The dedication ceremony is all about the parents' promise to offer their children to the Lord and to raise them for the glory of God. WELCOME TO THE BCA KIDS NURSERY

The BCA Kids nursery exists to provide children ages **newborn to 24 months** the very best in a warm and caring environment, one where young children learn that church is a safe and secure place. We believe it is important that children develop warm feelings about church at a very young age.

CHECKING YOUR CHILD INTO THE NURSERY

WELL-CHILD NURSERY

For the protection of all the children, we cannot admit a child who has been ill within the previous 24 hours with any of the following symptoms: fever, vomiting, discharge from eyes, cloudy nasal mucous, excessive coughing, diarrhea, rashes, head lice, or any communicable diseases. Colds, flu, and ear infections are assumed contagious as long as the child exhibits symptoms. If a child has a clear runny nose due to allergies, the child may be admitted to the classroom, but a parent will be notified if the child's nose is wiped more than three times during service.

FIRST-TIME GUEST CHECK-IN

Please check in at our first-time guest station outside the double doors to the nursery area. Please be sure to alert us of any allergies or special medical needs your child may have. Check-in begins 15 minutes before the start of each service.

SECURITY BRACELETS

In order to maintain maximum security, we attach a security bracelet to your wrist and a matching security bracelet to your child's ankle. Please do not remove this bracelet from your wrist. It uniquely matches you to your child. Both bracelets will be removed by the nursery staff at the time you pick up your child.

PAGER

You will be issued a pager which will vibrate in the event our nursery staff needs to contact you. If your child needs you during a worship service, your pager will vibrate, so please keep the pager with you at all times. Please return the pager at child check-out.

If for some reason you do not respond to the pager, we will post your security bracelet number on the screen in the worship center. The display will read "Parent # (your bracelet number)."

OUR NURSERY STAFF WILL PAGE YOU SHOULD YOUR CHILD NEED THE FOLLOWING:

Consolation only a parent can provide: Situations such as nursing babies or a child with separation anxiety that causes severe distress can only be consoled by a parent.

A diaper change: Please note that our nursery staff does not change babies' diapers. We contact the parent in the event a diaper change is needed.

Medical attention: If your child displays any signs of sickness (symptoms listed under the "well-child nursery" section of this flyer), we will notify you immediately so that you may pick up your child and care for his or her needs. Likewise, if your child needs any medication, we will notify you. Our nursery staff cannot administer any medication to your child.

Feeding: If your child needs to be nursed or needs baby food other than a baby bottle, we will contact you.

NAMETAGS & PERSONAL ITEMS

In addition to placing the nametag you received at guest check-in on your child, please use the other nametags provided to personalize all of your child's personal items before your arrival. This will help us keep track of your child's belongings.

SAYING GOODBYE

After you have completed the check-in process, simply tell your child goodbye at the security gate and enjoy the worship service in either the Worship Center or the Chapel. As you know, it is normal for little ones to cry when leaving a parent. This behavior usually does not last long, and separation becomes easier over time. If your child is inconsolable for more than 5 minutes, we will page you, unless instructed otherwise by you. Feel free to check on your little one at any time; however, we ask that you do so discreetly, trying not to let your child see you.

CHECKING YOUR CHILD OUT OF THE NURSERY

FORM A LINE TO PICK UP YOUR CHILD

Immediately following the worship service, please join the line of parents that are picking up their children. Please be patient with our staff during this time. We must insure that all children are properly picked up by their parents and this sometimes can take a few minutes.

MATCHING SECURITY BRACELETS

Our staff will match your security bracelet number to your child's security bracelet number. Please note: only the parent with the matching security bracelet can pick up their child. The nursery staff will remove these bracelets from both you and your child at the time of check out. Please do not remove your security bracelet before check out.

RETURN YOUR PAGER

Please remember to return the pager to our staff at the time you pick up your child.

PICK UP ALL OF YOUR BELONGINGS

If you left a diaper bag, baby bottle, or other items in the care of our nursery staff, please remind our staff to return these items to you at this time.
