#### What it says

Matthew 25:35-40— For I was <u>hungry</u> and you gave me something to eat, I was <u>thirsty</u> and you gave me something to drink, I was a <u>stranger</u> and you invited me in, I needed <u>clothes</u> and you clothed me, I was <u>sick</u> and you looked after me, I was in <u>prison</u> and you came to visit me.'

## 1. Christ's Command

#### **Foundational Scriptures**

>Matthew 25:35-40—For I was <u>hungry</u> and you gave me something to eat, I was <u>thirsty</u> and you gave me something to drink, I was a <u>stranger</u> and you invited me in, I needed <u>clothes</u> and you clothed me, I was <u>sick</u> and you looked after me, I was in <u>prison</u> and you came to visit me.' >John 13:34-35—A new command I give you: <u>Love</u> one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. <u>By this everyone will know</u> that you are my disciples, if you love one another.

>Acts 1:8—But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in <u>Jerusalem</u>, and in all <u>Judea</u> and <u>Samaria</u>, and to the <u>ends of the earth</u>.

>Matthew 22:37-40— Jesus replied: 'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments.

>James 1:27— Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world.
