

Proverbs 19:21—Many are the plans in a person's heart, but it is the Lord's purpose that prevails...

Genesis 7:1-4—The Lord then said to Noah, "Go into the ark, <u>you and your whole family, because I have found you righteous</u> in this generation. Take with you seven pairs of every kind of clean animal, a male and its mate, and one pair of every kind of unclean animal, a male and its mate, and also seven pairs of every kind of bird, male and female, to keep their various kinds alive throughout the earth. HOW TO LIVE A LIFE OF INFLUENCE

YOU: Live an authentic Christian life.

Luke 2:52—And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man.

Philippians 3:13-14—...Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

Acts 20:24—However, I consider my life worth nothing to me; my only aim is to <u>finish the race</u> and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me....

1 Corinthians 9:24-27—Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one gets the prize? Run in such a way as to get the prize. Everyone who competes in the games goes into strict training...

Galatians 5:7-8—<u>You were running a good race</u>. Who cut in on you to keep you from obeying the truth? That kind of persuasion does not come from the one who calls you..

Philippians 2:16—...And then I will be able to boast on the day of Christ that I <u>did not run or labor in vain.</u>

Hebrews 12:1-3—...And let us <u>run with perseverance the race marked out for us</u>, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith...

1 Timothy 4:7-8—...rather, <u>train yourself to be godly</u>. For physical training is of some value, but <u>godliness has value for all things</u>, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come.

2 Timothy 4:7-8—I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith...

2. YOUR FAMILY: Cultivate a strong, Christ-centered family.

Genesis 7:1—...Go into the ark, <u>you and your whole family</u>, because I have found you righteous. See also Deuteronomy 6:4-9; Colossians 3:21; Colossians 1:1-14; 4:2

3. OTHERS: Intentionally live to impact others.

Galatians 6:2—Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ. See also John 13:34-35
