## **ASSISI**

#### THE LEGACY OF ST. FRANCIS



- St. Francis of Assisi (1181–1226) was known for his humility, devotion, and care for creation.
- Founded the Franciscan order, emphasizing poverty, simplicity, and service.
- The Basilica of St. Francis houses stunning frescoes by Giotto depicting his life.

## **FLORENCE**

The Cradle of the Renaissance

- Florence was the center of the Renaissance, where faith, art, and intellect flourished.
- Key sites:
  - The Duomo (Florence Cathedral) A masterpiece of Gothic and Renaissance architecture.
  - Michelangelo's David A symbol of strength, beauty, and biblical inspiration.
  - Uffizi Gallery Home to world-famous religious paintings.



## **PISA**



#### The Iconic Leaning Tower

- Pisa's Leaning Tower (built 12th century) symbolizes architectural wonder.
- The Piazza dei Miracoli (Square of Miracles) includes:
- The Cathedral of Pisa
- The **Baptistery** (renowned for acoustics and sacred music).

### **VERONA**



A City of Romance and History

Verona is known for its rich Roman and medieval history.

- Key highlights:
  - The Arena of Verona A remarkably preserved Roman amphitheater.
  - Juliet's Balcony Inspired by Shakespeare's Romeo and Juliet.
  - Verona Cathedral (Duomo di Verona) A stunning example of Romanesque architecture.

## **VENICE**

Beauty, Faith, and History

Venice is a city of canals, cathedrals, and cultural depth.

- Key highlights:
  - St. Mark's Basilica A stunning example of Byzantine architecture.
  - Grand Canal & Gondolas A unique and timeless experience.
  - Murano glassmaking A tradition passed down for centuries.
