SPIRITUAL WEALTH: YOUR INTERNAL COMPASS

1. DECIDE: We must choose to receive Christ as Savior.

ROMANS ROAD

Romans 3:23—*For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.*

Romans 5:8—*But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.*

Romans 6:23—*For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

Romans 8:1—*Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus*

Romans 8:38-39—*For I am convinced... neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.*

Romans 10:9—*If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.*

Romans 12:1-2—*Therefore, I urge you... Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind...*

2. DISCIPLESHIP: We must choose daily to die to self and follow Christ as Lord.

PAUL'S PASSION

Luke 9:23—...Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me.

Acts 20:24—However, I consider my life worth nothing to me; my only aim is to finish the race and complete the task the Lord Jesus has given me—the task of testifying to the good news of God's grace.

Galatians 2:20—I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

3. DEVOTION: We must choose to continuously remain in Christ the King.

VINE DWELLING

6 KEYS

> Recognize Jesus as your source.

John 15:1,3—I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener... You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you.

> Realize that fruitfulness is expected.

John 15:2,8—He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so that it will be even more fruitful... This is to my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be my disciples.

> Remember that vine dwelling is vital.

John 15:4-6—Remain in me, as I also remain in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must remain in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you remain in me. I am the vine; you are the branches. If you remain in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. If you do not remain in me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned.

> Remind in/by prayer and Scripture.

John 15:7—If you remain in me and my words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you.

> Resolve to *LiveLoveLead* like Jesus.

John 15:9-13,17—As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love. If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and remain in his love. I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends... This is my command: Love each other.

> Recommit to living a life of uncompromising obedience.

John 15:14-16—You are my friends if you do what I command. I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you.
